

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 –  
SECTION 14(1)(a) AND 14(7)  
THE M6 MOTORWAY (JUNCTION 1  
TO JUNCTION 2) (TEMPORARY  
PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2021**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Highways England Company Limited (Company No. 9346363) has made an Order on the M6 Motorway, in the County of Warwickshire, to allow road joint replacement works to be carried out.

The effect of the Order will be to, at different times, –

- (1) close the northbound carriageway of the M6 from its junction with the exit slip road at Junction 1, to its junction with the entry slip road at Junction 2;
- (2) close the southbound carriageway of the M6 from its junction with the exit slip road at Junction 2, to its junction with the entry slip road at Junction 1;
- (3) close the entry slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the M6 at Junction 1;
- (4) close the entry slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the M6 at Junction 2; and
- (5) close lanes of –
  - (a) the northbound carriageway of the M6 from a point 600 metres west of the centreline of the B4455 Fosse Way overbridge, in a northwesterly direction for a distance of 1.8 kilometres; and
  - (b) the southbound carriageway of the M6 from a point 1.3 kilometres east of its junction with the entry slip road at Junction 2, in a southeasterly direction for a distance of 1.8 kilometres;

and allow traffic to run on the hard shoulder.

The work will be carried out in phases, overnight between 21:00 hours and 05:00 hours, and is expected to start on Tuesday 26 January 2021 and continue for two months. The lane closures with hard shoulder running will also be in operation for 24 hours per day between 21:00 on Tuesday 26 January 2021 and 05:00 hours on Saturday 30 January 2021. The Order will come into force on 19 January 2021.

Vehicles being used for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer purposes and vehicles being used in connection with the works or for winter maintenance purposes will be exempt from the closures.

Diversion routes via alternative junctions of the M6 will be signed.
