

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 –  
SECTION 14(1)(a)**

**THE M45 MOTORWAY (M1 JUNCTION 17  
TO THURLASTON) (TEMPORARY  
PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2021**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that  
Highways England Company Limited  
(Company No. 9346363) intends to make an  
Order on the M45 Motorway, in the Counties  
of Northamptonshire and Warwickshire, to  
allow resurfacing, traffic detector repairs  
and lining works to be carried out.

The effect of the Order will be to close –

- (a) the westbound carriageway of the  
M45 from its junction with the M1  
(M1 Junction 17), to its roundabout  
junction with the A45 and the B4229  
Coventry Road, at Thurlaston; and
- (b) the link road leading to the westbound  
carriageway of the M45 from the A45  
Daventry Road, at Dunchurch.

The work will be carried out over one night  
between 20:00 hours and 06:00 hours  
and is expected to start on Monday  
22 February 2021. The Order will come  
into force on 15 February 2021.

Vehicles being used for police, fire and  
rescue authority or ambulance purposes  
and vehicles being used in connection  
with the works or for winter maintenance  
purposes will be exempt from the closures.

Diversion routes via the M1, the M6 and  
the A46 for the carriageway closure and  
via the B4229 for the slip road closure will  
be signed.
