ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

FRANKTON LANE, FRANKTON

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between its junctions with Fair Close and Princethorpe Road.

Reason for Order: To enable the installation of a boundary box.

Order Commences: 10 February 2021 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 12 February 2021.

Access & Diversion: Frankton Lane, Princethorpe Road, Main Street, Frankton Road, Bourton Road, Fair Close and vice versa.

KINGSLEY AVENUE, RUGBY

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between the junctions with Hillmorton Road and Lower Hillmorton Road.

Reason for Order: Carriageway patching and associated works, 09.30hrs-15.30hrs.

Order Commences: 8 February 2021 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 9 February 2021.

Access & Diversion: A426, Langton Road, Lower Hillmorton Road and vice versa. Limited access to Kingsley Orchard and Edgecote Close.

PUBLIC FOOTPATHS BETWEEN MAGNET LANE, THE GREEN AND ALWYN ROAD, RUGBY

Order Effect: Public Footpaths between Magnet Lane, The Green and Alwyn Road will be closed to all traffic in phases as indicated.

Reason for Order: Footway reconstruction and associated works, weekdays only.

Order Commences: 8 February 2021 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion:

Phase 1 North Link 8 February – 11 February 2021.

Phase 2 South Link 15 February – 23 February 2021.

Access & Diversion:

North Path: The Green, Magnet Lane and vice versa.

South Path: Magnet, Main Street, Alwyn Road and vice versa.

ROUND GARDENS, NEW BILTON, RUGBY

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from the access road to Royal Court to the cul-de-sac end.

Reason for Order: To allow a safe working environment enabling maintenance works on telecoms equipment.

Order Commences: 8 February 2021 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 9 February 2021.

Access & Diversion: Traffic Management operatives will manage access/egress for properties affected. Access/egress to Levy Close will be affected.

SOUTHAM ROAD, DUNCHURCH

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between the junctions of Sandford Way and Toft Lane.

Reason for Order: Carriageway patching and associated works, 09.30hrs-15.30hrs.

Order Commenced: 14 August 2020 for up to 18 months. Unfortunately, works were delayed but have now been rescheduled to be completed between 09.30hrs & 15.30hrs on 8 February 2021.

Access & Diversion: A426, Daventry Road, A45, A425, A423, A426 and vice versa.

SPICER PLACE, RUGBY

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between its junction with Bilton Road and the north junction of Spice Place.

Order Commences: 11 November 2020 for up to 18 months. However, works were unavoidably delayed and have now been rescheduled to 8 February 2021.

Anticipated Completion: In one day on 8 February 2021.

Access & Diversion: Access to the remainder of Spice Place may be restricted while works are in progress.

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic along its entire length from its junction with Southam Road.

Anticipated Completion: 12 February 2021.

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from a point outside the plot adjacent to The Furrows.

Anticipated Completion: 26 February 2021.

Access & Diversion: Birdingbury Road, Stockton Road, Southam Road and vice versa.

Reason for Order: To enable works for the renewal of a water pipe.

Anticipated Completion: 25 February 2021.

Access & Diversion: Tower Road, Naseby Road, Faraday Road and vice versa.

For all of the above temporary orders, pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
