

## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

### CARLTON ROAD, RUGBY

**Order Effect:** Road closed to vehicular traffic between both junctions of Epsom Road.

**Reason for Order:** Carriageway patching and associated works, 08.00hrs-16.00hrs.

**Order Commences:** 15 February 2021 for up to 18 months.

**Anticipated Completion:** 15 February 2021.

**Access & Diversion:** Epsom Road and vice versa.

### CHURCH STREET & NORTH STREET, RUGBY

**Order Effect:** Road closed to vehicular traffic between the junctions of Railway Terrace and Park Road on two consecutive Sundays.
