

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

CHAPEL STREET & WEST STREET, LONG LAWFORD, RUGBY

Order Effect: Roads closed to vehicular traffic as follows: Chapel Street closed between properties number 15 and 25, West Street closed from its junction with Main Street to a point adjacent to property number 19.

SURFACE DRESSING NORTH WARWICKSHIRE 2021
