ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

CAWSTON LANE, DUNCHURCH

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between its junctions with Thurlaston Drive and Coventry Road.

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between the junctions of Carlton Road, Deepmore Road and Lytham Road.

Order Commences: 29 March 2021 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 31 March 2021.

Access & Diversion: Lytham Road, Overslade Lane, Deepmore Road and vice versa. Access to Carlton Road may be affected.

Anticipated Completion: 31 March 2021.

Access & Diversion: Hinckley Road, A5, Smockington Lane, Lutterworth Road and vice versa.

SCHOOL STREET, RUGBY

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between Brindley Road and Lower Street.

Reason for Order: Carriageway patching and associated works, 08.00hrs-16.00hrs.

Anticipated Completion: 29 March 2021.

Access & Diversion: School Street, Deerings Road, A428, Whitehall Road, Lower Hillmorton Road, The Kent and vice versa.

For all of the above temporary orders, pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
