ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

DRURY LANE, RUGBY

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from a point outside 7 Drury Lane to a point at the rear of 25 Sheep Street.
