ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

STOCKTON ROAD, NAPTON ON THE HILL

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from a point opposite to Cornwood Farm entrance.

Reason for Order: To safely enable utility works

Order Commences: 23 August 2021 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 25 August 2021

Access & Diversion: Stockton Road, Tomlow Road, Napton Road, Station Road and vice versa.

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

D2303 BRICKYARD LANE (BRICKYARD ROAD/OLD BRICKYARD LANE), NAPTON ON THE HILL

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from its junction with the A425 to the entrance to Canalside Yard.

Reason for Order: Carriageway patching and associated works, 09.30hrs-15.30hrs.

Order Commences: 8 September 2021 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 9 September 2021

Access & Diversion: A425, Butt Hill, Vicarage Road, Hackwell Street, High Street, New Street, Howcombe Lane, Poplar Road, Brickyard Road and vice versa.

HOLT ROAD, NAPTON ON THE HILL

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from a point close to Oak Tree Cottage to Holt Farm.

Reason for Order: To enable pole testing and tree cutting works.

Order Commences: 6 September 2021 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 6 September 2021

Access & Diversion: Butt Hill, Chapel Green Road, Daventry Road, Hackwell Street, High Street, New Street, Southam Road, Thorntons Lane, Vicarage Road, Welsh Road East and vice versa.

PLOUGH LANE & MANOR ROAD, BISHOPS ITCHINGTON

Order Effect: Roads closed to vehicular traffic as follows: Plough Lane closed between its junctions with Manor Road and St Michael's Close and Manor Road closed from a point outside property number 1 to the junction with Plough Lane.

Reason for Order: To enable works for the installation of a new water main.

Order Commences: 7 September 2021 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 26/10/2021 Work will be in two phases: Plough Lane – 7 September to 27 September 2021 and Manor Road – 28 September to 26 October 2021

Access & Diversion: 1st Diversion – Plough Lane, Gaydon Road (and vice versa) 2nd Diversion – Manor Road, Gaydon Road (and vice versa).

PRIORS HARDWICK ROAD, PRIORS HARDWICK

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from its junction with Leisure Drive.

Reason for Order: To enable gas works.

Anticipated Completion: 24 September 2021.
