ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

DUNCHURCH ROAD (SERVICE ROAD), RUGBY

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic.

Access & Diversion: Hillmorton Road, Lawrence Sheriff Street, Dunchurch Road, Russelsheim Way, Bilton Road, Warwick Street, Rugby Road, Ashlawn Road and vice versa.

GREEN LANE, BRINKLOW

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic.

Reason for Order: To enable installation of a new power supply.

Order Commences: 21 December 2021 for up to 18 months.

Access & Diversion: Green Lane, Coventry Road, Heath Lane and vice versa.
