

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

**Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:**

**A426 SOUTHAM ROAD & A426 RUGBY ROAD, DUNCHURCH**

**Order Effect:** Roads closed to vehicular traffic as follows:
