

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 -  
SECTION 14(1)(a)  
THE A5 TRUNK ROAD  
(WIBTOFT TO CHURCHOVER)  
(TEMPORARY RESTRICTION AND  
PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2022**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that National Highways Limited (Company No. 9346363) intends to make an order on the A5 Trunk Road, between Wibtoft and Churchover, in the Counties of Leicestershire and Warwickshire, to allow construction of an emergency access into a new industrial park to be carried out.

The effect of the Order will be to –

- (1) impose a 50 miles per hour speed restriction on the northbound carriageway of the A5 between points 1200 metres south and 900 metres south of the centrepoint of the roundabout junction with the A4303 Coventry Road, the B4428 Lutterworth Road and Coal Pit Lane (Cross in Hand Roundabout) at Lutterworth; and
- (2) impose a 40 miles per hour speed restriction on -
  - (a) the northbound carriageway of the A5 from a point 900 metres south of the centrepoint of Cross in Hand Roundabout, to its junction with Cross in Hand Roundabout;
  - (b) the southbound carriageway of the A5 from its junction with Cross in Hand Roundabout, to a point 1200 metres south of the centrepoint of Cross in Hand Roundabout; and
- (3) close –
  - (a) the A5 between its roundabout junction with the A426 and Gibbet Lane (Gibbet Roundabout), at Churchover, and its junction with Woodway Lane near Wibtoft; and
  - (b) any layby adjacent to the length of the A5 described in (3)(a) above.

The work is expected to start on Thursday 24 February 2022 and continue for a month. The closures will be carried out in two phases and are expected to be carried out overnight between 20:00 hours and 06:00 hours starting on Thursday 24 February 2022 for two nights and then from Sunday 27 March 2022 for two nights. The speed restrictions will be in operation from 06:00 hours on Saturday 26 February 2022 for 24 hours a day and continue for the duration of the work. The Order will come into force on 21 February 2022.

Vehicles being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes will be exempt from the speed restrictions and closures. Vehicles being used for special forces purposes will be exempt from the speed restrictions and vehicles being used in connection with the works or for winter maintenance purposes will be exempt from the closures. Access to properties will be maintained at all times.

Diversion routes via the A426, the A4303, the M1 and the M69 will be signed. Non-motorway traffic diversion routes via the B4114, the B581, Cooper Lane, the A426 and the A4303 and vice versa will be signed.
