

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14(1)(a) THE M1 AND M6 MOTORWAYS AND A14 TRUNK ROAD (M1 JUNCTION 19 TO JUNCTION 21) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2022

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that National Highways Limited (Company No. 9346363) has made an Order on the M1 and M6 Motorways and the A14 Trunk Road, in the Counties of Leicestershire and Warwickshire, to allow resurfacing and general maintenance work to be carried out,

The effect of the Order will be to close, at different times. –

- (1) the northbound carriageway of the M1 from its junction with the link road leading to the M6 at M1 Junction 19, to its junction with the entry slip road at Junction 21:
- (2) the southbound carriageway of the M1 from its junction with the exit slip road at Junction 21, to its junction with the link road leading from the M6 at M1 Junction 19;
- (3) any slip road or link road leading to or from the lengths of the M1 described in (1) and (2) above.

The work will be carried out in phases, overnight between 20:00 hours and 06:00 hours, and is expected to start on Friday 13 May 2022 and continue for approximately twenty weeks. During this period there is expected to be one full weekend closure, between 23:00 hours on Friday and 05:00 hours on Monday, of the M1 northbound entry slip at Junction 20. The Order will come into force on 9 May 2022.

Vehicles being used for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer purposes, and vehicles being used in connection with the works will be exempt from the closures.

Diversion routes via the A14, the A426, the M5, the A4303, the A5 and the M69 will be signed.
