

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

BIRDINGBURY ROAD/FRANKTON ROAD, BIRDINGBURY

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between the junctions with Bourton Lane and Back Lane.

Reason for Order: To enable bridge support works.

Order Commences: 4 July 2022 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 17 July 2022.

Access & Diversion: Main Street, Marton Lane, Birdingbury Road, A432 Coventry Road, A423 Oxford Road, Fosse Way, Rugby Road, Princethorpe Road, Frankton Lane, Cooks Lane, Birdingbury Lane and vice versa. Access to frontages will be maintained up to the extent of the bridge works.

MAIN STREET, HARBOROUGH MAGNA

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between its junction with Rugby Road and Church Close.

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between its junctions with Bath Street and Railway Terrace.

Access & Diversion: Bath Street, Craven Road, Railway Terrace and vice versa.

PUBLIC FOOTPATH FROM BOYCE WAY TO HOLBROOK ROAD, RUGBY

Order Effect: Footpath closed to ALL traffic.

Reason for Order: To enable essential substation works.

Order Commences: 18 July 2022 for up to 6 months.

Anticipated Completion: 5 August 2022.

Access & Diversion: Footpath from Boyce Way (same Footpath but other side of the green), Greenwood Close and vice versa.

For all of the above temporary orders, pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
