D31820 CHURCH WALK, RUGBY

- (1) Located on Cambridge Street; 53 metres north-east of its junction with Clifton Road (outside Cambridge Court 1-6, and Riley Court 9-10).
- (2) Road Hump dimension: 8.05m (width) x 4.0m (length) x 0.100m (height).
