

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

B4429 DAVENTRY ROAD, DUNCHURCH

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between M45/A45 Dunchurch Interchange and Guy's Common.
