## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

### **BALCOMBE ROAD, RUGBY**

**Order Effect:** Road closed to vehicular traffic between properties number 40 and 56.

**Reason for Order:** To enable essential maintenance works.

**Order Commences:** 14 August 2023 for up to 18 months.

**Anticipated Completion:** 22 August 2023.

**Access & Diversion:** Balcombe Road, Fareham Avenue, Ashlawn Road, Percival Road and vice versa.

### **COVENTRY ROAD & RUGBY ROAD, CHURCH LAWFORD**

**Order Effect:** Road closed to vehicular traffic between points 20 metres either side of the railway bridge.

**Reason for Order:** To enable safe removal of debris from accident location and installation of new steps for railway access, overnight 20.00-06.00hrs.

**Order Commences:** 13 August 2023 for up to 18 months.

**Anticipated Completion:** 14 August 2023.

**Access & Diversion:** Coventry Road, Rugby Road, Lawford Road, Rugby Western Relief Road, Blue Boar Flyover, Straight Mile, A45, Fosse Way and vice versa.

### **D33580 VERNON AVENUE, RUGBY**

**Order Effect:** Road closed to vehicular traffic between the junctions of Ashlawn Road and St Johns Avenue.

**Reason for Order:** Carriageway patching and associated works, 08.00hrs-16.00hrs.

**Order Commences:** 14 August 2023 for up to 18 months.

**Anticipated Completion:** 17 August 2023.

**Access & Diversion:** St Johns Avenue, Fareham Avenue, Ashlawn Road and vice versa.

### **SCHOOL STREET, CHURCH LAWFORD**

**Order Effect:** Road closed to vehicular traffic.

**Reason for Order:** To enable installation of new water connections.

**Access & Diversion:** School Street, Coventry Road.

### **THE WARWICKSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (BOROUGH OF RUGBY) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT AREA) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS, ON-STREET PARKING PLACES AND RESIDENTS' PARKING) (CONSOLIDATION) (MINOR ORDER VARIATION L) ORDER 2023**

Warwickshire County Council has made the above named minor order, pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and The Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996, the effect of which will be to vary the existing Warwickshire County Council (Borough of Rugby) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Waiting Restrictions, On-Street Parking Places and Residents' Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2017 (as previously varied) to provide for the purchase of tickets for on-street parking via a card payment method). The charges for on-street parking and payment methods available are described in more detail in the Schedule below.

The minor order commences on Monday 4 September 2023.
