

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

C88 ALWYN ROAD, RUGBY

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between its junctions with B4642 Main Street and Northampton Lane.

Reason for Order: Footway reconstruction and associated works, 09.00hrs-15.30hrs week days only. Please note – The work will be completed in two phases between the dates as given.

Order Commences: 2 October 2023 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 15 November 2023.

Access & Diversion: Northampton Lane, A426, Rugby Gyration, Bilton Road, Main Street and vice versa. Access/Egress will be maintained where possible to businesses and residents only. Access/Egress to/from Lime Tree Avenue will be maintained where possible. No Access/Egress to/from Longwood Road and Juliet Drive whilst works are in progress.

Order Commenced: 1 April 2022 for up to 6 months or until the works to which it related were completed whichever was the sooner; following direction from the Secretary of State the Order was extended and was due to expire 30 September 2023. However, the Secretary of State in exercise of his powers under Section 15(5) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 has issued a further direction that the Order shall continue in force until **29 March 2024**, or until works are completed, whichever is the earlier (unless the Secretary of State issues a further direction).
