CHURCH LANE, LAPWORTH

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Church Lane, Lapworth to vehicular traffic.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D5047 SPRING LANE, LAPWORTH

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing D5047 Spring Lane, Lapworth from its junction with Wharf Lane, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate carriageway patching works.

The Order will commence on 16 October 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed in one day on 16 October 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
