## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BUTTS LANE, TANWORTH IN ARDEN

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Butts Lane, Tanworth in Arden at the junction with Well Lane, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the clearance of duct blockages.

The Order will commence on 8 December 2017 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 12 December 2017.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Butts Lane, Doctors Hill, Well Lane (and vice versa).

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF STATION LANE, LAPWORTH

Warwickshire County Council made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Station Lane, Lapworth from the junction of Yew Tree Lane, to vehicular traffic.

The closure was required to facilitate carriageway patching works.

The Order commenced on 20 June 2017 for a period of 18 months, or until the works were completed, whichever was the earlier.

Due to unforeseen circumstances the works did not go ahead as planned but have now been rescheduled to commence on 30 November 2017. It is anticipated that the work will be completed in one day.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Station Lane, B4439 Old Warwick Road, Mill Lane, Rising Lane, Station Lane and vice versa.
