ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF MALTHOUSE LANE, EARLSWOOD

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Malthouse Lane, Earlswood from a point outside property number 3, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works to clear blockages.

The Order will commence on 13 January 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed in one day on 13 January 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Malthouse Lane, Earlswood Lakes Causeway, Valley Road, Earlswood Common, Springbrook Lane (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CHURCH LANE, LAPWORTH

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Church Lane, Lapworth from a point approximately 42 metres from its junction with Old Warwick Road to a point opposite Mountfield Farm, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to safely facilitate works for the installation of 130 metres of duct in the verge.

The Order will commence on 4 January 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 13 January 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Church Lane, Old Warwick Road, Wharf Lane, Spring Lane (and vice versa).
