TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D5021 MOWS HILL ROAD, TANWORTH IN ARDEN

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing D5021 Mows Hill Road, Tanworth in Arden from Kemps Green Road to Nuthurst Road, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the removal of loose debris & grass growth from the centre of the road and to remedy pot holes exposed in the tarmac.

The Order will commence on 5 February 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 10 February 2018.

Please note: The work will be carried out between 09.00hrs and 17.00hrs on weekdays only.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Kemps Green Road, Nuthurst Road and vice versa.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CATESBY LANE, LAPWORTH Warwickshire County Council proposes to make

a Temporary Traffic Order closing Catesby Lane, Lapworth from a point approximately 48 metres north east of its junction with Lapworth Street to its junction with Old Warwick Road, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the clearance of blockages.
