ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF RUSHBROOK LANE, TANWORTH IN ARDEN

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Rushbrook Lane, Tanworth in Arden for a distance of approximately 40 metres between Penn Lane and Broad Lane, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for the laying of a new domestic service.

The Order will commence on 5 March 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 8 March 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Rushbrook Lane, Broad Lane, Penn Lane (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D5028 BUTTS LANE, TANWORTH IN ARDEN

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing D5028 Butts Lane, Tanworth in Arden from Doctors Hill to Well Lane to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate drainage (ditching) works.

The Order will commence on 5 March 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 8 March 2018.

Please note: The works will be completed between 09.30hrs and 15.30hrs daily.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Well Lane, Doctors Hill and vice versa.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF C23 RISING LANE, BADDESLEY CLINTON

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing C23 Rising Lane, Baddesley Clinton from Netherwood Lane to the Canal Bridge, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate draining works, ditching and pipe repairs.

The Order will commence on 7 March 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 13 March 2018.

Please note: The works will be carried out between 09.30hrs and 15.30hrs on week days.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Rising Lane, Haywood Lane, Finwood Road, Rowington Green, Old Warwick Road, Packwood Lane, Rising Lane and vice versa.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF TOM HILL, TANWORTH IN ARDEN

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Tom Hill, Tanworth in Arden from its junction with Broad Lane and for a distance of approximately 830 metres in a southerly direction, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to safely allow engineers to work in an underground structure.

The Order will commence on 5 March 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 9 March 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Tom Hill, Doctors Hill, The Green, Vicarage Hill, Broad Lane (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF LAPWORTH STREET, LAPWORTH

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Lapworth Street, Lapworth, between Catesby Lane and Bredon House, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to safely facilitate works for electrical line reconductoring.

The Order will commence on 20 March 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 23 March 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Lapworth Street, Catesby Lane, Old Warwick Road, Finwood Road, Mill Lane (and vice versa).
