ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF TOM HILL, TANWORTH IN ARDEN

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order dosing Tom Hill, Tanworth in Arden between Broad Lane and the property known as Yew Tree Cottage, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works for LV line reconductoring.

The Order will commence on 29 March 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed in one day on 29 March 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SHEPHERDS LANE, PACKINGTON

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Shepherds Lane, Packington from Maxstoke Lane to the A45, to vehicular traffic.
