## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF DANZEY GREEN LANE, TANWORTH IN ARDEN

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Danzey Green Lane, Tanworth in Arden from the junction of Butts Lane to a point approximately 80 metres from Pump House, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to facilitate works to locate and clear duct blockages.

The Order will commence on 26 April 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 30 April 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Danzey Green Lane, Butts Lane, Tom Hill, Broad Lane, Pound House Lane, Spring Lane, Stratford Road, Aylesbury Road,to Boundary (2326-2679), Stratford Road, M40 Jct 16 to M42 Jct 3a, Liveridge Hill, Birmingham Road, Tanworth Lane, Mill Lane (and vice versa).

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SHEPHERDS LANE, PACKINGTON
