## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984. **SECTION 14**

### TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D431 HAUNCH LANE, LEA MARSTON

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing D431 Haunch Lane, Lea Marston from its junction with Church Lane to its junction with A4097 Kingsbury Road, to vehicular traffic. PLEASE NOTE: Access to and egress from The Green

may be affected while works are in progress. The closure is required to facilitate carriageway resurfacing works.

The Order will commence on 17 December 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 20 December 2018.

#### PLEASE NOTE: The works will be carried out between 08.00hrs and 17.00hrs.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible. An alternative route will be signed and is available via:

Church Lane, Hams Lane, Faraday Avenue, A446 Litchfield Road, A4097 Kingsbury Road and vice versa. The Council regrets any inconvenience that may be caused. The team dealing with this Temporary Traffic Order at Warwickshire County Council is County Highways North (Tel: 01926 412515).

### TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CHESSETTS WOOD ROAD, LAPWORTH

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Órder closing Chessetts Wood Road, Lapworth from a point outside Chessetts Paddocks and for a distance of approximately 100 metres towards the junction with Rising Lane, to vehicular traffic.

The closure is required to provide a safe working environment for Openreach engineers to access the telegraph poles.

The Order will commence on 14 December 2018 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed in one day on 14 December 2018.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Chessetts Wood Road, Packwood Road, Packwood Lane, Rising Lane (and vice versa).
