The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Colebrook Road, Shirley) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2018

The Council gives notice that it has made the above Order under Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991) to allow railway infrastructure works to be undertaken. **Colebrook Road, Shirley** will be closed either side of the railway bridge from **Monday 14th January to Friday 25th January 2019** (2200hrs to 0600hrs each night – weekdays only). Alternative routes signed via Colebrook Road, Haslucks Green Road, Green Lane and Aqueduct Road. Vice versa for the other direction. Access for emergency services will be maintained. The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Poplar Road, Solihull) (Bus Gate) Order 2019

Notice is hereby given that the Solihull Metropolitan Borough Council, in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to that Act, proposes to make the following Order. **Proposed Bus Gate (Prohibition of Driving except Permitted Vehicles) (24 Hours – All Days)** Poplar Road, Solihull – from the exit to the Marks & Spencer Car Park, in a southerly direction (toward Station Road) for a distance of 10 metres along the southbound carriageway only. As a consequence of the above proposals, the following existing provisions shall be revoked: The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Solihull Gateway Project) (Prohibition of Driving, No Entry and Prohibition of Turning Movements) Order 2014: Poplar Road into Station Road – “from the boundary of property No. 34/38 Poplar Road, south west then north west into Station Road, to a point 10 metres north west of its junction with Herbert Road, a distance of approximately 210 metres, on the running side of the carriageway only”.
