Reason: Setting of Listed Building **Development:** Upgrade the existing floodlighting system on the main stadium pitch. The new system will consist of 41 No. 2kW HID floodlights, and these will be installed onto the existing 7 No. 16m galvanised lighting masts that are currently installed around the perimeter of the stadium pitch. This will increase the lighting level to 500 lux, in the event of the club achieving promotion this system will meet the requirements of the next league in the football pyramid.

(Burtons Way Smith's Wood)
(Temporary Road Closure) Order 2019**

The Council has made the above Order under Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991), to allow drainage connection works to be undertaken. **Burtons Way, Smith's Wood, B36 0UG** will be closed approximately 20m north of Smith's Wood Primary School for a distance of approximately 20m from **0800hrs on Saturday 16th February to 1700hrs on Sunday 24th February 2019**. Alternative routes will be signed via Windward Way, Auckland Drive, Kingfisher Drive and Arran Way. Access for emergency services cannot be maintained through the restriction. Pedestrian and vehicle access to all properties within the restriction and access through the restriction will be maintained along defined routes throughout the period of the closure. Tanhouse Farm Road) (Temporary
Footpath Closure) Order 2018**

The Council gives notice that it intends to make the above Order under Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991), being satisfied that pedestrian traffic should be restricted or prohibited to allow footpath improvement works to be undertaken in safety. **Footpath SL3 – from the junction with Lode Lane to the junction with Tanhouse Farm Road** will be closed from 0800hrs on Monday 25th February to 1800hrs on Sunday 31st March 2019.
