TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D5021 MOWS HILL ROAD, KEMPS GREEN, TANWORTH IN ARDEN

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing D5021 Mows Hill Road, Kengs Green, Tanworth in Arden from its junction with Kemps Green Road to its junction with Nuthurst Road, to vehicular tr

The closure is required to facilitate carriageway patching works.

The Order will commence on 25 March 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 28 March 2019.
