ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF VALLEY ROAD, EARLSWOOD

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Valley Road, Earlswood, including a section of the access road that runs alongside the lake, to vehicular traffic. The closure is required to facilitate ground investigation works to assess the safety of the dam.

The Order will commence on 1 April 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 5 April 2019.
