

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF WELL LANE, TANWORTH IN ARDEN

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Well Lane, Tanworth in Arden to vehicular traffic. The closure is required to facilitate works for the laying of a new gas main.

The Order will commence on 22 May 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 5 June 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Well Lane, Doctors Hill, Knowlebury Cross, Butts Lane, Mile End (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF WHARF LANE, TANWORTH IN ARDEN

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Wharf Lane, Tanworth in Arden, from a point outside The Oaks to a point outside Fathings, to all traffic. The closure is required to facilitate utility works.

The Order will commence on 6 May 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Wharf Lane, Old Warwick Road, Stratford Road (and vice versa).
