Notice is hereby given that Solihull Metropolitan Borough Council, Council House, Manor Square, Solihull B91 3QB, intends to make a prescribed alteration to Hazel Oak Special School, Hazel Oak Road, Shirley, B90 2AZ by relocating the post-16 department of Hazel Oak School to Solihull College, Blossomfield Road, Solihull, B91 1SB from 1 September 2019.

Hazel Oak School is a special school for pupils aged 4 - 18 with Moderate Learning Difficulties. Solihull Council, in partnership with the Headteacher and Governors of Hazel Oak School, are proposing to relocate Years 12 and 13 from the school site in Hazel Oak Road, Shirley to the Solihull College Campus on Blossomfield Road, Solihull. The pupils in the two year groups affected by this change will remain on the roll of Hazel Oak School and will continue to be educated by staff from the School, who will relocate and be based at the College campus. The College is providing a designated area within their campus to locate the School's post-16 provision.
