ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14 TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CUT THROAT LANE & SPRING LANE, EARLSWOOD

Warwickshire County Council has made a Temporary Traffic Order closing Cut Throat Lane & Spring Lane, Earlswood, to vehicular traffic.

Cut Throat Lane closure – from a point outside Heathfield Farm to the junction of Spring Lane.

Spring Lane closure – from a point outside property number 92 to Spring Coppice.

The closures are required to facilitate excavation works for the installation of a new water main.

The Order will commence on 13 May 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 5 July 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of roads to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Spring Lane, Pound House Lane, Broad Lane, Earlswood Common, Umberslade Road, Leafy Lane, Cut Throat Lane (and vice versa).

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF LAPWORTH STREET, LAPWORTH

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order closing Lapworth Street, Lapworth to vehicular traffic. The closure is required to facilitate utility works.

The Order will commence on 20 May 2019 and will last for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 25 May 2019.

Pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.

An alternative route will be signed and is available via: Lapworth Street, Old Warwick Road, Packwood Lane, Wharf Lane, Stratford Road, Wheatsheaf Lane, Bushwood Lane, Tapster Lane, Yew Tree Lane (and vice versa).
