NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, at the dates, times and locations set out below, an Issue Specific Hearing will be held by the Examining Authority (appointed by the Secretary of State) for the examination of the application made by Highways England Company Limited of Bridge House, 1 Walnut Tree Close, Guildford, GU1 4LZ for a Development Consent Order ("the DCO") for the M42 Junction 6 ("the Application").

The Application was made to the Secretary (via the Planning Inspectorate) under sections 14, 22 and 37 of the Planning Act 2008 on 02 January 2019 and was accepted by the Planning Inspectorate for examination on 30 January 2019. The Application has been given the Planning Inspectorate reference number TR010027.

SUMMARY OF THE SCHEME

The Application seeks development consent for the M42 Junction 6 DCO in the West Midlands region, located within the administrative areas of Solihull Metropolitan Borough Council, Warwickshire County Council and North Warwickshire Borough Council ("the Scheme").

The main aspects of the Scheme comprise:

- A new junction (Junction 5A), approximately 1.8km south of the existing junction 6;
- The construction of a new 2.4km dual carriageway link road between the new junction and Clock Interchange (an existing junction on the A45);
- Modifications to the existing Clock Interchange junction;
- Upgrades to the existing junction 6; and
- Realignments and improvements to local roads to the west of the existing M42 in proximity to the proposed bypass.

If the DCO is made by the Secretary of State, it would allow Highways England, for the purpose of constructing, operating and maintaining the Scheme, to acquire compulsorily interests in and rights over land, including the power to create and acquire new rights over land, and to take possession of and to use land temporarily.

The DCO would also make provision for development, which would constitute associated development together with other ancillary matters, including those related to:

- the permanent construction and alteration of streets,
- the temporary and permanent stopping up of streets,
- public rights of way and private means of access in the vicinity of the scheme
- land required temporarily for the diversions of public utilities apparatus
- the classification of roads all included within the scheme
- along with the amendment, disapplication and modification of relevant legislation.

HEARINGS
