NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that SOLIHULL METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL made a Direction under Article 4(1) of the Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) (England) Order 2015, as amended (hereafter referred to as "the Order") on 07 June 2019.

The Direction applies to development described in Schedules I and II below and applies to land in the vicinity of St. Bernard's Road within Olton Conservation Area (hereafter referred to as "the Land"), as shown edged black on the plans attached to the Direction.

The effect of the Direction is that permission granted by Article 3 of the Order shall not apply to development of the type specified in Schedules I and II to this Notice and that such development shall not be carried out on the Land unless planning permission is granted by the Council, as the local planning authority, on an application made to the Council under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

A copy of the Direction and plans showing the Land affected can be viewed at Solihull MBC Council House, Manor Square, Solihull B91 3QB during normal office hours.

The period for making representations to the Council commences on 14 June 2019. The Direction takes effect on 07 June 2019 and shall remain in force until 06 December 2019 (being six months from the date made) and shall then expire, unless it has been confirmed by the Council before the end of the six month period. In deciding whether or not to confirm the Direction, the Council will consider any representations received during the consultation period.
