

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT
1984 – SECTION 14(1)(a)
THE M42 (JUNCTION 3A TO
JUNCTION 6) (CONNECTING ROADS)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF
TRAFFIC) ORDER 2019**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Highways England Company Limited (Company No. 9346363) has made an Order on the M42 Motorway, in the City of Birmingham, the Metropolitan Borough of Solihull and the County of Warwickshire, to allow structural inspections and cyclical maintenance works to be carried out.

The effect of the Order will be to close, at different times, –

- (1) any slip road leading to or from the M42 at Junctions 4, 5 and 6;
- (2) the link road leading from the eastbound carriageway of the M42 to the northbound carriageway of the M42 at Junction 3a; and
- (3) the link road leading from the northbound carriageway of the M40 to the northbound carriageway of the M42 at Junction 3a.

The work will be carried out overnight between 21:00 hours and 05:30 hours and is expected to start on Wednesday 19 June 2019 and continue for one month. The Order will come into force on 17 June 2019.

Vehicles being used for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer purposes and vehicles being used in connection with the works will be exempt from the closures.

Diversion routes via the M40 and alternative junctions of the M42 will be signed.
