The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Shakespeare Drive, Shirley – Service Road) (Disabled Parking Bays) Order 2019

The Order, which comes into force on 27 September 2019, will introduce the following: **Designation of Disabled Parking Bays (Parking Limited to Blue Badge Holders at All Times)** Shakespeare Drive, Service Road – One new marked blue badge holder parking bay located approximately 33m from the entrance to the service road. **Revocation of existing Limited Waiting Bays** Shakespeare Drive, Service Road – Two marked limited waiting parking bays located approximately 33m from the entrance to the service road.

The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (A452 Collector Road, Smith's Wood) (Temporary Traffic Restrictions) Order 2019

The Council gives notice that it intends to make the above Order under Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991), being satisfied that traffic should be restricted or prohibited to allow crash barrier renewal works to be undertaken in safety. **A452 Collector Road, Smiths Wood (banned right-hand turn into Lanchester Way)** Thursday 26th September 2019 to Tuesday 8th October 2019 (9pm – 6am reduced hours each night). Alternative routes for traffic will be signed via A452 Collector Road. **A452 Collector Road, Smiths Wood (banned right-hand turn into Auckland Drive)** Thursday 26th September 2019 to Tuesday 8th October 2019 (9pm – 6am reduced hours each night). Alternative routes for traffic will be signed via A452 Collector Road. Informatory warning signs will be deployed, not less than seven days before any particular road will be closed. Access for emergency services **will not** be maintained through the restriction. Pedestrian and vehicle access to all properties within the restriction and access through the restriction will be maintained along defined routes throughout the period of the closure.
