The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Various Roads – Kingshurst and Fordbridge) (Total Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 2019

The Council has made this Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, the Traffic Management Act 2004 and the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of Solihull) Order 2007, where applicable, and all other enabling powers. The reasons for this Order can be obtained by written request from the address below; or by inspecting the documents at Solihull Connect, Library Square, Touchwood, Solihull during normal opening hours or via www.solihull.gov.uk/Resident/Parking-travel-roads/roadworks-and-restrictions/tros A copy of the Order is available upon request. Anyone wishing to question the validity or provisions of the Order should apply to the High Court within six weeks from the date that the Order became effective. The Order, which comes into force on 21 November 2019, will introduce the following: **Total Prohibition of Waiting** Blackcat Close – (i) west side from a point 28m south of Woodclose Road in a generally north then north westerly direction to Chelmsley Road a distance of approx' 66m; (ii) east side from Chelmsley Road, southwards for approx' 12m; (iii) east side from Sheepclose Drive, northwards for approx' 17m and (iv) east side from Sheepclose Drive, southwards for approx' 17m. Chapelhouse Road – (i) northern side from Arderne Drive eastwards for approx' 20m; and (ii) northern side from Arderne Drive westwards for approx' 15m. Chelmsley Road – (i) southern side from Blackcat Close, north eastwards for 23m; and (ii) southern side from Blackcat Close, north westwards for 15m. Sheepclose Drive – both sides from Blackcat Close, eastwards for approx' 15m. Woodclose Road – both sides from Blackcat Close, westwards for approx' 15m.

The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (B4102 Meriden Road, Hampton in Arden) (Total Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2019

The Council has made this Order, with minor modifications, under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, the Traffic Management Act 2004 and the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of Solihull) Order 2007, where applicable, and all other enabling powers. The Order, which comes into force on 21 November 2019, will introduce the following: **Total Prohibition of Waiting** B4102 Meriden Road – northern side from a point approximately 35m north east of its south western junction with the service road fronting 1-11 north eastwards for 58m. B4102 Meriden Road – southern side from a point approximately 10m north east of the north eastern junction with the service road fronting 1-11 south westwards for 60m. B4102 Meriden Road (service road fronting 1-11) – southern side from a point approximately 10m of its south western junction with Meriden Road north eastwards for the remainder of its length. B4102 Meriden Road (service road fronting 1-11) – northern side from a point approximately 15m south west of its north easterly junction with Meriden Road B4102 north eastwards for the remainder of its length.
