The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Footpath within Elmdon Nature Park, Elmdon) (Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2019

The Council gives notice that it intends to make the above Order under Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991), being satisfied that pedestrian traffic should be restricted or prohibited to forestry works to be undertaken in safety. The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Wootton Lane, Balsall Common) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2019

The Council gives notice that it has made the above Order under Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991), being satisfied that traffic should be restricted or prohibited to allow BT telecommunication apparatus works to be undertaken in safety.
