Notice Of Hearing

Notice is hereby given that a hearing will be taking place on 28th January 2020 in front of a Planning Inspector on behalf of the Secretary of State for Transport in respect of The Birmingham Airport (Rights over Land) Order 2020. The hearing will take place at 10.00am at the 'voco' St John's Solihull Hotel, 651 Warwick Road, Solihull, B91 1AT.

Description of the Proposed Order

Birmingham Airport are seeking an order under s44 of the Civil Aviation Act 1982 to acquire rights over the Order Land. The Order relates to land which is outside of the current airport boundary and lies within the areas defined as being subject to obstacle limitation requirements in accordance with EASA Certification Specifications and Guidance Material for Aerodrome Design (CS-ADR-DSN) and Civil Aviation Authority publication CAP 1732.

The rights sought include rights over and in the Order Land to cut down, alter, restrict or remove any shrub, hedge or tree so as to bring the airport into conformity with the obstacle limitation requirements and the right to enter upon said land for such purposes as often as may be reasonably necessary.

Description of the Order Land

The parcels of land in the Order are shown in the plan referred to in the Order ('the Order Map'). The Order Land is coloured red on the Order Map and is located to the South East of the existing airport and A45 Coventry Road and includes land on Clock Lane, Catherine-de-Barnes Lane, St Peters Lane, Church Lane, land north of the access to the Warwickshire Gaelic Athletic Sports ground and public highway land.
