ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

WHEATSHEAF LANE, LAPWORTH

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from its junction with A3400 Stratford Road.

Reason for Order: To facilitate works for the replacement of a telegraph pole.

Order Commences: 13 January 2020 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: In one day on 13 January 2020.

Access & Diversion: Stratford Road, Bushwood Lane, Wheatsheaf Lane and vice versa.

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

C89 LEAFY LANE (ALSO KNOWN AS CUT THROAT LANE), EARLSWOOD

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from the junction with Salter Street to the junction of Umberslade Road.

Reason for Order: To facilitate carriageway patching & associated works.

Order Commences: 28 January 2020 for 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: In one day on 28 January 2020 between 08.00hrs and 16.00hrs.

Access & Diversion: Umberslade Road, Tithe Barn Lane, Leafy Lane (Cut Throat Lane) and vice versa.

For all of the above temporary orders, pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
