The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Birmingham Business Park, Marston Green) (Total Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2018 (Part 2)

The Council has made the remaining part of this Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, the Traffic Management Act 2004 and the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of Solihull) Order 2007, where applicable, and all other enabling powers. Anyone wishing to question the validity or provisions of the Order should apply to the High Court within six weeks from the date that the Order became effective. The Order, which comes into force on 13 February 2020, will introduce the following: **Total Prohibition** of Waiting (At Any Time) New access road to Birmingham Business Park between Bickenhill Parkway and Solihull Parkway provisionally named Progress Way both sides from a approximately 209 metres north of its junction with Bickenhill Parkway (roundabout) northwards to the junction of Solihull Parkway (roundabout). Solihull Parkway (southern side) – from its junction with Progress Way (roundabout) south eastwards for 15 metres.

The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Footpath – Redlands Road to Cornyx Lane) (Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2020

The Council gives notice that it intends to make the above Order under Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991), being satisfied that pedestrian traffic should be restricted or prohibited to allow works to be carried out to upgrade a footpath to a shared cycle way are to be undertaken in safety. The footpath between Redlands Road and Cornyx Lane, Solihull will be closed from (8am) Monday 17th February until (4pm) Friday 27th March 2020. Alternative routes for pedestrian traffic will be signed via Redlands Road, Glebe Road and Cornyx Lane. Vice versa for the other direction. Informatory warning signs will be deployed, not less than seven days before any footpath is closed. Access for emergency services will be maintained at all times. Where applicable, pedestrian access to all properties within the restriction will be maintained along defined routes throughout the period of the closure.
