The proposals are: Proposed Prohibition of Driving all vehicular traffic Monday-Friday between 8.30am-9.10am and 2.45pm-3.45pm along **Clifton Crescent** for its entire length. Proposed Prohibition of Driving all vehicular traffic Monday-Friday between 8.30am-9.10am and 2.45pm-3.45pm along **Windrush Close** for its entire length. Proposed Prohibition of Driving all vehicular traffic Monday-Friday between 8.20am-9.00am and 2.45pm-3.45pm along **Wayside** for its entire length. Proposed 20mph Maximum Speed Limit (24 hours/7 days per week) along **Clifton Crescent, Windrush Close** and **Wayside** for their entire lengths.

The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Ravenshaw & Ravenshaw Lane) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 2020 and The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Ravenshaw Way & A41 Solihull By-pass) (Red Route) Order 2020

The Council proposes to make these Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, and all other enabling powers. The proposals are: **Proposed Prohibition of Driving – All Vehicular Traffic – 24 hours/7 days per week** Ravenshaw – from its junction with Ravenshaw Way, north-westwards to where it crosses the River Blythe. A total distance of approximately 390 metres. Ravenshaw Lane – from where it crosses the River Blythe, north-westwards for approximately 40 metres. Exemptions will apply for access to adjacent land and property; and to pedestrians, equestrian users and cyclists. **Proposed Revocation** As a consequence of the above proposals, The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Ravenshaw Lane, Solihull) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1988 is revoked in its entirety and its provisions re-enacted by this Order. **Proposed Red Route - No Stopping At All Times – All Vehicular Traffic – 24 hours/7 days** Ravenshaw Way (both sides) – from its junction with A41 Solihull By-pass, north-eastwards for approximately 60 metres. A41 Solihull By-pass/unnamed access road leading to sub station (both sides) – from its junction with the main carriageway of the A41 north-eastwards for the entire length of public highway, a length of approximately 15 metres.

The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Footpath – Redlands Road to Cornyx Lane) (Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2020

The Council gives notice that it has made the above Order under Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991), being satisfied that pedestrian traffic should be restricted or prohibited to allow works to be carried out to upgrade a footpath to a shared cycle way are to be undertaken in safety. The footpath between **Redlands Road and Cornyx Lane, Solihull** will be closed from **(8am) Monday 17th February** until **(4pm) Friday 27th March 2020**. Alternative routes for pedestrian traffic will be signed via Redlands Road, Glebe Road and Cornyx Lane. Vice versa for the other direction. Informatory warning signs will be deployed, not less than seven days before any footpath is closed. Access for emergency services will be maintained at all times. Where applicable, pedestrian access to all properties within the restriction will be maintained along defined routes throughout the period of the closure. The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Hatchford Brook Road, Solihull) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2020

The Council gives notice that it intends to make the above Order under Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991), being satisfied that traffic should be restricted or prohibited to allow water main renewal works to be undertaken in safety. **Hatchford Brook Road, Solihull** will be closed from the junction with Old Lode Lane to Ventnor Road/Tanford Road roundabout from **(9am) Monday 24th February** to **(5pm) Friday 20th March 2020**.

Alternative routes for traffic will be signed via Tanford Road, Fallowfield Road, Tanhouse Farm Road and Old Lode Lane. Vice versa for the other direction. Informatory warning signs will be deployed, not less than seven days before any particular road will be closed. Access for emergency services will be maintained through the restriction. Pedestrian and vehicle access to all properties within the restriction and access through the restriction will be maintained along defined routes throughout the period of the closure. The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Baulk Lane, Balsall Common) (Temporary Road Closure) Order 2020

The Council gives notice that it intends to make the above Order under Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991), being satisfied that traffic should be restricted or prohibited to allow the installation of new cables to be undertaken in safety. **Baulk Lane, Balsall Common** will be closed from the junction of Truggist Lane to the junction of Spencers Lane from **Monday 24th February** to **Friday 6th March 2020 (0800-1800hrs)**. Alternative routes for traffic will be signed via Spencers Lane and Truggist Lane. Vice versa for the other direction.
