The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Ravenshaw & Ravenshaw Lane) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 2020 and The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Ravenshaw Way & A41 Solihull By-pass) (Red Route) Order 2020

The Council has made these Orders under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, and all other enabling powers. The reasons for the Orders can be obtained by written request from the address below; or by inspecting the documents at Solihull Connect, The Core, Theatre Square, Touchwood, Solihull during normal opening hours or via www.solihull.gov.uk/Resident/ Parking-travel-roads/roadworks-and-restrictions/tros A copy of the Orders are available upon request. Anyone wishing to question the validity or provisions of the Orders should apply to the High Court within six weeks from the date that the Orders became effective. The Orders, which come into force on 4 June 2020, will introduce the following: Prohibition of Driving - All Vehicular Traffic - 24 hours/7 days per week Ravenshaw - from its junction with Ravenshaw Way, north-westwards to where it crosses the River Blythe, A total distance of approximately 390 metres. Ravenshaw Lane - from where it crosses the River Blythe, north-westwards for approximately 40 metres. Exemptions will apply for access to adjacent land and property; and to pedestrians, equestrian users and cyclists. Red Route - No Stopping At All Times - All Vehicular Traffic - 24 hours/7 days Ravenshaw Way (both sides) - from its junction with A41 Solihull By-pass, north-eastwards for approximately 60 metres. A41 Solihull By-pass/unnamed access road leading to sub station (both sides) - from its junction with the main carriageway of the A41 northeastwards for the entire length of public highway, a length of approximately 15 metres. Revocation As a consequence of the above proposals. The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Ravenshaw Lane, Solihull) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1988 is revoked in its entirety and its provisions re-enacted by these Orders.

Establishment of a Parallel and Zebra Crossings

Notice is hereby given that the Council, in accordance with Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended), and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police, intends to construct and commission new Parallel or Zebra crossing facilities at the following locations. They will take effect on or after 31 July 2020. Further details for this scheme may be obtained by written request from the address given below or, alternatively, inspected at Solihull Connect, located off Theatre Square, Touchwood, Solihull during normal opening hours:

Road/Street	Location
Station Road	Parallel crossing – approximately 3m south-east from the junction with Malthouse Row.
Windward Way	Parallel crossing – approximately 25m south of the access to Smith's Wood Academy.
Widney Lane	Zebra crossing - opposite No. 130 Widney Lane.
Colebrook Road	Zebra crossing - opposite No. 136 Colebrook Road.
