

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 –
SECTION 14(1)(a)**

**THE M42 (JUNCTION 4 TO JUNCTION 6)
(SLIP ROADS) (TEMPORARY
PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2020**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Highways England Company Limited (Company No. 9346363) has made an Order on the M42 Motorway, in the Metropolitan Borough of Solihull, to allow cyclic maintenance works to be carried out.

The effect of the Order will be to close –

- (1) any slip road leading to or from the northbound or southbound carriageways of the M42 at Junction 4;
- (2) any slip road leading to or from the northbound or southbound carriageways of the M42 at Junction 5; and
- (3) any slip road leading to or from the northbound or southbound carriageways of the M42 at Junction 6.

The work will be carried out overnight between 21:30 hours and 05:30 hours and is expected to start on Wednesday 17 June 2020 and continue for eight nights. The Order will come into force on 10 June 2020.

Vehicles being used for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer purposes and vehicles being used in connection with the works, will be exempt from the closures.

Diversion routes via alternative junctions of the M42 will be signed.
