

PUBLIC NOTICE OF AN APPLICATION FOR A CLUB PREMISES CERTIFICATE UNDER SECTION 84 OF THE LICENSING ACT 2003

Notice is hereby given that an application was made to SOLIHULL METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL for a variation of a Club premises certificate under the above Act on the 2nd September 2020.

Applicant: **Camp Hill Rugby Club Ltd**

Address of premises: **Rear of 119/121 Haslucks Green Road, Shirley, Solihull, West Midlands B90 2EF**

The application seeks to vary the Club Premises Certificate as follows:

- **To amend the name on the Club Premises Certificate (CPC) to Camp Hill Rugby Club Ltd**
- **Request the use of glasses within the patio area, immediately adjoining the clubhouse and remove the requirement to use plastic glasses within this area**
- **Add the use of an outside bar to our CPC; opening hours will be as CPC currently states, and usage is anticipated to be mainly match days, beer festival and bonfire night**
- **Be able to supply alcohol for consumption off the premises; there is no intention to provide a place for such consumption**

It is an offence, under Section 158 of the Licensing Act 2003, to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement on or in connection with an application and the maximum fine on summary conviction of such an offence is £5000.
