

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(1)(a)
THE M42 MOTORWAY (JUNCTION 6 TO JUNCTION 5)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2020**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Highways England Company Limited (Company No. 9346363) has made an Order on the M42 Motorway, in the Metropolitan Borough of Solihull, to allow bridge repairs to be carried out.

The effect of the Order will be to close, –

- a) the southbound carriageway of the M42 from its junction with the exit slip road at Junction 6, to its junction with the entry slip road at Junction 5; and
- b) the entry slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the M42 at Junction 6.

The work will be carried out overnight between 22:00 hours and 06:00 hours and is expected to start on Monday 26 October 2020 and continue for 5 nights. The Order will come into force on 19 October 2020.

Vehicles being used for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer purposes and vehicles being used in connection with the works or for winter maintenance purposes will be exempt from the closures.

A diversion route via the A45, Damson Parkway South and the A41 will be signed.

THE M42 AND M40 MOTORWAYS (M42 JUNCTION 3a)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2020**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Highways England Company Limited (Company No. 9346363) has made an order on the M42 and M40 Motorways, in the County of Warwickshire, to enable street lighting work to be carried out.

The effect of the Order will be to close the link road leading from the southbound carriageway of the M42, at Junction 3a, to the southbound carriageway of the M40.

The work will be carried out over two nights, on weekdays only, between 22:00 hours and 05:45 hours and is expected to start on Friday 23 October 2020 and then on Monday 26 October 2020. The Order will come into force on 19 October 2020.

Vehicles being used for police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer purposes, and vehicles being used in connection with the works or for winter maintenance purposes will be exempt from the closure.

A diversion route via M42 Junction 3 will be signed.
