ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

D5039 STATION LANE (STATION ROAD), KINGSWOOD/LAPWORTH

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from its junction with Old Warwick Road to the entrance of Lapworth Train Station Car Park.

Reason for Order: Carriageway resurfacing and associated works, 09.30hrs-15.30hrs.

Order Commenced: 26 May 2020 for up to 18 months. **However, due to the Coronavirus Pandemic the works have had to be rescheduled. Works will now be carried out as follows:**

Scheduled start 26 October 2020 Anticipated completion 29 October 2020.

Access & Diversion: Old Warwick Road (B4439), Packwood Lane, Rising Lane and vice versa.

Warwickshire County Council proposes to make the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

NETHERWOOD LANE, BADDESLEY CLINTON

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from the junction of Arbour Tree Lane.

Reason for Order: Tree cutting to clear overhead power lines, 08.30hrs-16.00hrs.

Order Commences: 2 November 2020 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: In one day on 2 November 2020.

Access & Diversion: Netherwood Lane, Arbour Tree Lane, Warwick Road, Birmingham Road, Rising Lane and vice versa.

VALLEY ROAD, EARLSWOOD

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic from a point outside Westbrook to a point opposite Brook House.

Reason for Order: Works to build precast chambers and installation of poly duct.

Order Commences: 9 November 2020 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 13 November 2020.

Access & Diversion: Valley Road, Shutt Lane, Salter Street, Tanworth Lane, Lady Lane, Cleobury Lane 09112020 and vice versa.

Contractor: Conley Utilities, Tel: 01675 446 285.

For all of the above temporary orders, pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
