ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Warwickshire County Council has made the following Temporary Traffic Orders:

C20 POOLHEAD LANE, TANWORTH IN ARDEN

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between its junctions with Broad Lane and Forshaw Heath Lane.

Reason for Order: Carriageway patching and associated works, 09.00hrs-15.00hrs.

Order Commences: 15 January 2021 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: In one day on 15 January 2021.

Access & Diversion: Poolhead Lane, Forshaw Heath Road, Rumbush Lane, Norton Lane, Valley Road, Earlswood Common, Broad Lane and vice versa.

CHESSETTS WOOD ROAD, LAPWORTH

Order Effect: Road closed to vehicular traffic between its junctions with Chapel Lane and Packwood Road.

Reason for Order: To enable works for the renewal of a water pipe.

Order Commences: 20 January 2021 for up to 18 months.

Anticipated Completion: 22 January 2021.

Access & Diversion: Chessetts Wood Road, Packwood Road, Vicarage Road, Packwood Lane, Rising Lane and vice versa.

For all of the above temporary orders, pedestrian access to and egress from properties and land situated adjacent to the length of road to be closed will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access will be maintained where possible.
