The Order, which comes into force on 31 March 2021, will introduce the following: **Proposed Permitted Waiting for Electric Vehicle Charging Only – (All Days – At Any Time):** Wharf Lane, Solihull (eastern side); Cornwood Lane, Dickens Heath (south western side); Swanswell Road, Olton (south western side); Stratford Road east side (service road fronting Henleydale), Shirley (western side of service road); Tanhouse Farm Road, (south western side); Dunster Road, Chelmsley Wood (western side); Burtons Way, Smiths Wood (western side); and Winchester Drive, Chelmsley Wood (western side). **Proposed Permitted Waiting for Electric Vehicle Charging Only – (Monday to Saturday – 0800hrs to 1800hrs – Maximum Stay 2hrs – No Return within 2hrs) – (Unlimited Waiting on Sundays and at All Other Times):** Stratford Road eastern side (service road), Shirley; Haslucks Green Road, Shirley (south eastern side); Stratford Road western side (service road) Shirley; and Stratford Road eastern side (service road), Shirley (western side of service road). **Proposed Revocation of Existing Restrictions and Amendments to Existing Orders:** To enable the provisions of these new Orders to take effect it will be necessary to revoke a number of existing waiting restrictions currently in place along lengths of road affected by these proposals.
