The Metropolitan Borough of Solihull (Shadowbrook Lane, Hampton in Arden) (Prohibition of Left Turn Movements) Order 2021

The Council has made this Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, and all other enabling powers. Anyone wishing to question the validity or provisions of the Order should apply to the High Court within six weeks from the date that the Order became effective. The Order, which comes into force on 5 August 2021, will introduce the following: **Prohibition of Left Turn Movements Shadowbrook Lane (junction opposite Fentham Road)** – prohibition of left turn into High Street, Hampton in Arden.

(The Green, Meriden) (Blue Badge Holder Designated Parking Places) Order 2021

The Council has made this Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, the Traffic Management Act 2004 and the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Metropolitan Borough of Solihull) Order 2007, where applicable, and all other enabling powers. (Chester Road, Kingshurst) (Road Closure) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2021

The Council gives notice that it intends to make the above Order under Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991), being satisfied that all traffic should be restricted or prohibited to ensure that the following telecoms works can be undertaken in safety along Service Road adjacent Chester Road, Kingshurst, B36 0JU – from its junction with Buckingham Road to property number 489 Chester Road from Thursday 5th August 2021 to Friday 20th August 2021. The road will only be closed to through traffic from 08:00hrs to 17:00hrs daily. (Service road will be re-opened overnight). (Illshaw Heath Road, Shirley) (Road Closure) Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2021

The Council gives notice that it intends to make the above Order under Sections 14 and 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991), being satisfied that all traffic should be restricted or prohibited to ensure that the following service connection works can be undertaken in safety along Illshaw Heath Road, Shirley, B90 – from the junction with Dyers Lane to property number 102 from Monday 9th August 2021 at 00:00hrs until Tuesday 20th August 2021 at 00:00hrs (24-hour restriction). Diversion route: Signed via Creynolds Lane, A34, A3400 and Kineton Lane. Vice versa for the opposite direction.
